Laxatives

♦ COLAC HERBS is a laxative that contains 2 herbal medicine-derived ingredients (Sennosides, glycyrrhiza extract powder), and promotes bowel movement in a natural way. Sennosides improves bowel movement, and glycyrrhiza extract powder supports the act of Sennosides, promoting defecation.

Indication

1) Constipation2) Relief of the following symptoms due to constipation: dull headache, hot flush, skin roughness, eruption, loss of appetite (anorexia), fullness in the abdomen, abnormal fermentation in the intestines, and hemorrhoids

Dosage and administration

Take the following dose with cold or lukewarm water at bedtime (or on an empty stomach). However, start with a minimum dose and increase or decrease the dose gradually depending on bowel movement or conditions.

15 years or over: 1 to 2 tablets per dose, once daily

Under 15 years: Do not take

Comply with the prescribed dosage and administration instructions.

How to take out the tablets

- ·As shown in the figure, press the convex part of the PTP sheet containing the tablet firmly with your fingertips, break the aluminum foil on the back side, and take out the tablets.
- (If the tablets are inadvertently taken together with the PTP sheet containing them, it will lead to unexpected accidents, such as the sharp edge sticking into the esophageal mucosa.)

ingredient and amount

In 2 tablets

Sennoside 57.12mg (SennosideA·B 24mg)

Powdered Glycyrrhiza extract 80mg (equivalent to 560 mg of the crude drug)

Excipients

cellulose, Croscarmellose sodium, Magnesium stearate, Talc

When not to use the product

(If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions are more likely to occur.) This drug should not be taken together with the following drugs:

For those who are lactating, do not use this medicine or avoid lactating while using this medicine.

Do not take an excessive amount of this medicine

Precautions for storage and handling

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Avoid direct sunlight, and store the product in a cool place with little humidity.

Store the product beyond the reach of children.

Do not transfer the drug to other containers. (It may lead to misuse or quality deterioration)

Do not take the product past the expiration date.

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
