Indication

constipation

Dosage and administration

12 year or over: Insert 1 piece per dose into the rectum, and, if it is not effective, insert 1 more piece. Do not use in children under 12 years. (This is a drug to be inserted through the anus. Do not take orally.)

Comply with the prescribed dosage and administration instructions.

After taking the drug, wait until the urge to defecate becomes strong.

(If you try to defecate immediately after using the drug, the drug alone may be eliminated, thus resulting in no efficacy.) The use of the drug for children ≥ 12 years old should be supervised by a parent.

If the drug is too soft, cool it for a while before use.

If the drug is too hard, leave the drug in room temperature for a while, and use it after it gets soft enough. Use the drug only for the anus.

Precautions for storage and handling

Avoid direct sunlight, and store in a cool place with little humidity and temperature below 30℃.

After opening the aluminum bag, the unused drug should be stored in a cool place ($\leq 15^{\circ}$ C) without direct sunlight. Store the product beyond the reach of children.

For storage, place the tip downward, and return it to the aluminum bag, and store in the outer box, stand them according

to the instruction on the outer box.
