

IRIS GUARD P

Class 2 OTC drug

Eye drops

◆ IRIS GUARD P is an eye drop that contains an anti-inflammatory agent pranoprofen. ■ Pranoprofen inhibits the generation of substance that causes inflammation (prostaglandin), and alleviates such symptoms as the sense of foreign objects in the eye (irritating and tingling sensation), watery eye, blood shot, and itching. ■ The eye drop with gentle cool sensation.

Indication

To alleviate the following eye symptoms: foreign-body sensation (irritating/pricking sensation), watery eye, conjunctival injection, itching in the eye, and blurred vision with excessive eye mucus

Dosage and administration

Instill 1 to 2 drops per dose 4 times daily.

Comply with the prescribed dosage and administration instructions.

When allowing children to use the medicine, a guardian must be present to watch and tell such them how to use it.

Do not touch the tip of the container with the eyelid or eyelash. Do not use the drug when the solution becomes turbid.

Do not use the drug while wearing contact lenses. (Remove the lenses before using the drug.)

Use this only as an eye drop.

ingredient and amount

Pranoprofen 0.05%

Excipients

Boric acid, pH adjusting agent, Edetate sodium, BHT, Benzalkonium chloride, l-Menthol, dl-Camphor, Polysorbate 80

Precautions

When not to use the product

(If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions are more likely to occur.)

● This product should not be used in the following persons:

Children younger than 7 years old

Pregnant women or women suspected of being pregnant.

Nursing women.

Consultation

● The following persons should contact a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation before use.

Patients undergoing medical treatment from a physician

Patients who have experienced allergic symptoms associated with drugs, etc.

Persons with the following symptoms:

Severe eye pain

Persons diagnosed as having the following:

Glaucoma

If the following symptoms are observed after taking this drug, these may be adverse reactions, so immediately discontinue the use of this drug, and show this document to your physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation.

Skin

rash/redness

itching

Eyes:

congestion of the eye

itching

swelling

Irritation

foreign-body sensation, watery eye, eye mucus

Other:

breathing difficulties, difficulty in breathing

● In case of the following, stop taking this medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson, being sure to take this instruction leaflet with you.

if symptoms worsen owing to the use of the drug,

When blurred vision does not improved.

Glaucoma is considered.

● When symptoms do not improve even after using this medicine for about 3 days, stop taking this medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson, being sure to take this instruction leaflet with you.

Take the drug for more than 2 weeks even if the symptoms have been relieved.

Precautions for storage and handling

Store in a cool, low humidity place away from direct sunlight.

Don't leave the drug to a place where the temperature becomes high - e.g. inside a car and near a heater. In order to prevent quality degradation by light, tightly close the cap, and put the drug in the attached light-shield pouch.

Store the product beyond the reach of children.

Do not transfer the drug to other containers. (It may lead to misuse or quality deterioration)

Do not share the drug with other people.

Do not use the product past the expiration date. Even within the expiration date, try to use it up as soon as possible once it is opened (to assure the quality).

The crystalized ingredient may accumulate at the tip of the container and inside the cap depending on the storage conditions. Wipe the crystalized ingredient with a clean gauze.

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
