ANTIMICROBIAL IRIS

Class 2 OTC drug
<Eye Drops>

ANTIMICROBIAL IRIS is a single-use eye medicine that contains no preservatives and feels gentle on the eyeball with no sting on the way in, and is an effective treatment for styes, conjunctivitis or similar eye conditions caused by bacterial infection.



Precautions for Use



Things You Must Not Do

(Failure to follow these precautions may lead to your current symptoms worsening or a greater chance of side effects occurring)

- The following individuals should not use this product:**
Persons who have had allergic symptoms as a result of taking these eye drops or any of its components.*
- Do not use for long periods of time**



Things To Consult On

- The following individuals should consult with their doctor, pharmacist, or a registered seller before using this medicine.**
 - Persons receiving treatment from a doctor.
 - Persons who have had allergic symptoms due to medication or similar substances in the past.
 - Persons with the following symptom:
Intense eye pain
- If any of the following symptoms appear after you have used this medicine, you may be experiencing side effects. As such, please discontinue use immediately and consult with your doctor, pharmacist or registered seller, bringing a copy of this instruction sheet with you.**



Relevant Area	Symptoms
Skin	Rash, redness, itching
Eyes	Red eye, itching, swelling

* In rare cases, the following serious symptoms may occur. In such cases, see a doctor immediately.

Symptom Name	Symptoms
Shock (Anaphylaxis)	Itching, hives, hoarse voice, sneezing, itchy throat, breathlessness, palpitations, and brain fog immediately after taking this medicine.

- If symptoms do not improve after approximately 3 to 4 days of using this medicine, discontinue use and consult with your doctor, pharmacist, or registered seller, bringing a copy of this instruction sheet.**

Efficacy

Styes, conjunctivitis (pink eye), blepharitis (inflammation of the eyelids), itchy eyes

For eye symptoms, including:

Stye



Inflammation at or near the root of the eyelashes caused by a bacterial infection. The eyelids turn red and swollen, accompanied by itching.

Conjunctivitis (Pink eye)



Often contracted in swimming pools or similar locations and causes hyperemia of the conjunctiva (white of the eye and the back of eyelids) and itching.

Blepharitis (Inflammation of the eyelids)



Causes symptoms such as swelling, inflammation, or itching along the edges of eyelids due to bacterial infection, etc.

Components

Components	Amount	Action
Sulfamethoxazole sodium	4.0%	Highly effective against the bacteria that cause styes and conjunctivitis.
Dipotassium glycyrrhizinate	0.1%	Relieves eye inflammation caused by bacterial infection, etc.

Excipients: pH-adjusting agent, one other component ingredient

Note:


You may experience a bitter or sweet taste in your mouth after putting drops of this product into your eyes. The bitterness is caused by the active ingredient sulfamethoxazole sodium and the sweetness by the active ingredient dipotassium glycyrrhizinate, so there is no need to worry.

Usage/Dosage


Apply to eyes 3 to 6 times daily, 2 to 3 drops each time.

[How to Use]

(1) Slowly twist the cap to open. Do not pull the cap forcefully.




(2) Apply to eyes 3 to 6 times daily, 2 to 3 drops each time. (One vial may be used for both eyes.)



(3) The container contains some extra solution to ensure it squeezes out of the vial easily. However, the container must be discarded once opened even if there is solution remaining.

Sort as plastic.



Note:

- (1) Strictly follow the prescribed usage and dosage.
- (2) If this medicine is being used by a child, ensure it is used under the guidance and supervision of a parent or guardian.
- (3) Do not let the tip of the container touch your eyelids or eyelashes. Do not use if the solution is cloudy.
- (4) Do not use while wearing soft contact lenses.
- (5) Use only for application in the eyes.
- (6) Do not open by pulling forcefully. Avoid using excessive force when opening the vial. This may cause the solution to spatter.
- (7) **ANTIMICROBIAL IRIS** is a single-use ophthalmic solution and contains no preservatives. Discard any remaining solution after use.



Be careful not to injure your eyes with the tip of the container.

Precautions for Storage and Handling

- (1) Store the product in a cool place that is out of direct sunlight.
- (2) Store this product out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer to another container. (This may result in misuse or a change in quality.)
- (4) Do not share the eye drops with anyone else.
- (5) These eye drops use colored vials in colored bags in order to prevent any changes to the quality of their liquid contents. However, please keep the eye drops in a location out of direct sunlight when storing them, such as returning them to their box. Do not store these eye drops in the refrigerator.
- (6) Do not place eye drops in high-temperature locations, such as on the dashboard of your car. (The container may deform or the quality of the solution may deteriorate.)
- (7) Avoid putting the product in the back pocket of your pants or other such places as the cap may open.
- (8) Do not use this product beyond its expiration date. Use this medicine as soon as possible after opening, even if still within the expiration date. (In order to ensure quality)



Precautions about Styes

Avoid rubbing your eyelids or otherwise triggering any eye irritation. (Although getting a stye is something you can have a predisposed susceptibility to, you are more likely to develop one when you are weakened from overwork or lack of sleep, etc. Try to avoid getting overworked and make sure to get enough sleep.)
