# TAISHO STOMATITIS CHEWABLE TABLETS

◆ TAISHO STOMATITIS CHEWABLE TABLETS is an oral stomatitis drug that quickly dissolves in the mouth to exert a good effect on painful and smarting stomatitis. ■ It can be taken without water and easily at any place.

#### Indication

stomatitis

Pharyngitis, tonsillitis (sore throat, and swollen throat.)

## Dosage and administration

Take the following dose by chewing or dissolving the drug in the mouth.

Adults (15 years or over): 2 tablets per dose, 3 times daily

7 to 14 years: 1 tablet per dose, 3 times daily

Under 7 years: Do not take

Dipotassium Glycyrrhizinate

### Excipients

cellulose, anhydrous silicic acid, Corn starch, D-Mannitol, Crospovidone, Aspartame (L- phenylalanine compound), Acesulfame K, Sucralose, Citric acid, Magnesium stearate, Flavoring, Starch sodium octenyl succinate

# Precautions relating to ingredient and amount

No need to worry if you have yellow urine after taking the drug because it is caused by the vitamin B2 contained in the drug.

# When not to use the product

(If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions are more likely to occur.)

• This medicine should not be taken together with any of the following medicines:

internal medicines containing glycyrrhiza or its main component glycolyl

internal medicines containing Tranexamic Acid (Oral Remedies for Rhinitis, cold medicine, Antipyretic Analgesics expectorants, etc.),

• Do not take this medicine for a long time

#### Consultation

• The following persons should contact a physician, dentist, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation before administration.

Pregnant women, nursing women, or women suspected of being pregnant.

Persons who have had an allergic symptom to drugs.

• When symptoms do not improve even after taking the medicine 5 to 6 times, stop taking this medicine and consult a physician, dentist, pharmacist or registered salesperson, being sure to take this instruction leaflet with you.

## Precautions for storage and handling

Avoid direct sunlight, and store the product in a cool place with little humidity.

Store the product beyond the reach of children.

Do not transfer the drug to other containers. (It may lead to misuse or quality deterioration.)

After opening the inner bag (Aluminum bag), store it in a place where it will not be exposed to light, such as returning it to a box, in order to prevent discoloration due to light.

Do not use the product past the expiration date. Even before the expiration date, use the product within 6 months after it is opened (to assure the quality).

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
