# **PITARITTO**

antidiarrheal

◆ Diarrhea is caused by excessive bowel movement by dyspepsia due to excessive eating/drinking and stress, or excessive secretion of water in the bowel. ◆ Pitaritto contains loperamide hydrochloride which alleviates over active bowel movement, inhibits water secretion in the bowel, and promotes water absorption. It works well for painful diarrhea.

#### Indication

Diarrhea, diarrhea due to excessive eating/drinking, diarrhea due to chills caught in sleep, diarrhea associated with abdominal pain, food poisoning, water poisoning, soft stools

## Dosage and administration

Take the following dose with cold or lukewarm water. Do not take the drug when diarrhea stops. Provide a dosing interval for at least 4 hours.

Adults (15 years or over): 2 tablets per dose, twice daily

Under 15 years: Do not take

## [Precaution]

Comply with the prescribed dosage and administration instructions.

How to take out the tablets

•Press the convex part of the PTP sheet containing the tablet firmly with your fingertips, break the aluminum foil on the back side, and take out the tablets.

(If the tablets are inadvertently taken together with the PTP sheet containing them, it will lead to unexpected accidents, such as the sharp edge sticking into the esophageal mucosa.)

## ingredient and amount

In 2 tablets

Loperamide Hydrochloride 0.5mg 0.5mg

Berberine chloride 75mg

Biodiastase2000 45mg

Thiamine Nitrate (Vitamin B1) 7.5mg

Riboflavin (Vitamin B2) 3mg

#### Excipients

Sugar, Corn starch , cellulose, Magnesium aluminometasilicate , Hydroxypropylcellulose, anhydrous silicic acid , Magnesium stearate, Hypromellose, Macrogol , Titanium oxide, Carnauba wax

#### [Precaution]

No need to worry if you have yellow urine after taking the drug because it is caused by the vitamin B2 contained in the drug.

#### Precautions

## When not to use the product

(If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions/incidents are more likely to occur.)

• This product should not be taken in the following persons.

Patients who have had an allergic symptom to this drug or its ingredients.

• This drug should not be taken together with the following drugs:

Pain relief/antispasmodic medicine for the stomach

- After taking this drug, do not drive a car or operate machinery (sleepiness may occur).
- Do not drink alcohol before and after taking this drug.

#### Consultation

• The following persons should contact a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation before administration.

Patients undergoing medical treatment from a physician

Those who have diarrhea with fever, bloody stool or persistent mucous stool.

Those who have acute and severe diarrhea or diarrhea with accompanying symptoms such as abdominal pain/abdominal distension/sick feeling. (The disease may worsen by taking this medicine to stop diarrhea.)

Persons with anal disease for which constipation should be avoided. (The drug may cause constipation.)

Pregnant women or women suspected of being pregnant.

Nursing women.

The elderly

Patients who have experienced allergic symptoms associated with drugs, etc.

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• If the following symptoms are observed after taking this drug, these may be adverse reactions, so immediately discontinue the use of this drug, and show this document to your physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation.

Skin: rash/redness itching

Gastrointestinal system: constipation, feeling of fullness in the abdomen, Stomach discomfort, nausea and vomiting, abdominal pain,

Loss of appetite

Neuropsychiatric system:dizziness

The following serious symptoms may occur in rare cases. In such cases, immediately seek medical aid from a physician. Shock (anaphylaxis): Symptoms, such as itching of skin, urticaria, hoarseness, sneezing, itchy throat, breathing difficulties, palpitations, and clouding of consciousness may occur immediately after take.

Oculomucocutaneous syndrome (Stevens-Johnson syndrome), toxic epidermal necrolysis: Hyperthermia, ocular hyperaemia, eye discharge, lip erosion, pain throat, widespread skin rash/redness, etc. may persist or suddenly worsen. Ileus-like symptoms (symptoms like intestinal obstruction): severe abdominal pain, stopping gas discharge (fart), vomiting, and severe constipation with abdominal distention may develop.

- The following symptoms may be observed after taking this drug. If these symptoms persist or worsen , discontinue the use of this drug, and show this document to your physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation. Drowsiness
- If symptoms do not improve even after using this medicine for 2 to 3 days, stop taking this medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson, being sure to take this instruction leaflet with you.

## Precautions for storage and handling

Avoid direct sunlight, and store the product in a cool place with little humidity.

Store the product beyond the reach of children.

Do not transfer the drug to other containers. (It may lead to misuse or quality deterioration)

Do not use the product past the expiration date. Even before the expiration date, use the product within 6 months after it is opened (to assure the quality).
