Indication

Stiff shoulders, lumbago, muscular pain, muscular fatigue, joint pain, frostbite, contusions, sprains

Dosage and administration

Apply an appropriate dose onto the lesion several times daily.

Precaution

- The use of the drug for children should be supervised by a parent. Children under 13 years old should not use this drug because it may cause tingling sensations.
- Attention should be paid so that the drug does not come into contact with the eyes. If the drug comes into contact with the eyes, immediately rinse well with cold or lukewarm water. If the symptoms are severe, seek medical attention from an ophthalmologist.
- The drug is for external use only. Do not take it orally.
- Do not use the drug in 1 hour before taking a bath. If you take a bath immediately after using the drug, you may experience a strong tingling sensation.
- If your skin is sensitive, do not apply the drug to the same site continuously.
- Apply a small amount of the drug on the inner arm before use, and confirm that no rash/redness, itching, eruption, and pain occurred.
- Dry the skin area to which the drug is applied. When the drug is not dried well, the drug may discolor the clothes.
- If you feel a strong tingling sensation, wash gently the affected site with whipped soap, rinse it off, and cool the site well.
